### **Krieger + Associates Begins Feasibility Study for Holy Trinity Lutheran**

*Philadelphia, PA (October 5, 2017)* – Krieger + Associates Architects Inc. has begun a feasibility study on behalf of the Property Committee of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Narberth, PA. The original stone church was built in the 1920's, with a three-story multi-purpose parish hall building added 20 years later. The Committee has hired Krieger to investigate potential renovations and improvements to the parish hall.

The firm's architects will investigate possible alterations to add accessibility for older congregants and better flow between the hall and the church's sanctuary. They will also look at ways to increase space in the parish hall for community meals, to accommodate the church's expanding education program, and to provide adequate meeting spaces for other community groups. The study will include a general site review, code reviews, and reviews of the building's structural and systems soundness. Proposed schemes and construction cost estimates will be provided, so that Trinity Lutheran will have the details they need to begin a fund-raising campaign.
